



## City of Fredericksburg Public Hearing on Proposed Increases in FREdericksburg Regional Transit Fares

The City of Fredericksburg will hold a public hearing on proposed fare changes for FREdericksburg Regional Transit (FRED) during the May 23, 2017, council meeting to be held at City Hall. The hearing, scheduled to begin at 7:30 PM, is an opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed fare changes. ### FARE INCREASE

The proposed fare increases for FRED bus service would apply in all jurisdictions served by FRED: the City of Fredericksburg and the counties of Spotsylvania, Stafford and Caroline. The proposed increases are summarized below, and would go into effect on July 1, 2017.

Half-Fare	\$0.50	\$0.60
